FACILITIES DEVELOPMENT GOALS

MTC 601

Mitchell Technical College accepts the premise that educational facilities should reflect and support the mission of MTC. The College further recognizes that educational programs are neither unchanging nor simple to incorporate into a facility plan. Anticipation of program change makes the need for flexible use of buildings necessary.

School buildings will be functionally compatible with desired learning experiences. The programs, not the physical setting, will dictate the manner in which buildings are used.

Planning facilities priorities must be established to make the best use of the College funds. The College's first objective will be to develop a plan that provides adequate space for each student's educational development. Whenever possible, the cultural as well as educational needs of the community will be considered in planning facility expansion.

Architects retained by MTC will be expected to plan for simplicity of design; sound economics, including low long-range maintenance costs, efficiency in energy needs, and low insurance rates; high educational use; and flexibility.
