BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS SECURITY

MTC 521

Buildings constitute one of the greatest investments of the College. It is in the best interest of students and taxpayers to protect that investment adequately.

Security should mean not only maintenance of a secure (locked) building, but also:

1. Minimizing fire hazards.
2. Reducing the probability of faulty equipment.
3. Guarding against the chance of electrical shock.
4. Keeping records and funds in a safe place.
5. Protection against vandalism and burglary.

Regular campus hours will be set by the President. Off-hour access will be granted and tracked electronically to protect the campus and those who utilize its resources. Student areas that are available past business hours will only be available via electronically granted and tracked access to individual students.
