## FUNDS FROM FEDERAL SOURCES

**MTC 424**

Funds for educational purposes made available by the federal government will be accepted by Mitchell Technical College providing the conditions of their availability align with the purposes and policy of the College and state statutes.

No person shall, on the basis of race, color, ethnicity, creed, religion, gender, sexual orientation, disability, national origin or ancestry, age, military/veteran status, genetic information, or any other basis protected by law, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance.

It is the policy of the College that no federal funds received by contract, grant, loan, or cooperative agreement may be expended to pay any person for influencing or attempting to influence an office or employee of any agency, a member of Congress, an officer or employee of Congress or an employee of a member of Congress in connection with any of the following covered federal actions: the awarding of any federal contract, the making of any federal grant, the making of any federal loan, the entering into of an cooperative agreement and the extension, continuation, renewal, amendment or modification of any federal contract, grant, loan or cooperative agreement.

Further, if funds from another source have been paid or will be paid to any person for influencing or attempting to influence in connection with a federal contract, grant, loan, or cooperative agreement, the President or their designee shall complete and submit a Disclosure Form to Report Lobbying.
