BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS SECURITY

MTI 521

Buildings constitute one of the greatest investments of the Institute. It is in the best interest of students and taxpayers to protect that investment adequately.

Security should mean not only maintenance of a secure (locked) building, but also:

1. Minimizing fire hazards.
2. Reducing the probability of faulty equipment.
3. Guarding against the chance of electrical shock.
4. Keeping records and funds in a safe place.
5. Protection against vandalism and burglary.

The Institute's buildings shall normally be considered closed to all persons between 11:30 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., unless permission is given by the building supervisor.
