BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS MAINTENANCE

MTI 525

The Institute will provide facilities that are safe from hazards, sanitary, properly equipped, lighted and ventilated and esthetically suited to promoting the goals of higher education.

The President will have direct supervision of the care of the Institute. He will be responsible to the Board for its adequate maintenance.

The President will have responsibility for the institution's facilities and grounds. The President or his designee will carry on a continuous inspection of all buildings, equipment, and grounds to discover conditions that may be dangerous to the health, safety or comfort of the students or staff. The Dean of Fiscal Operations and the Buildings and Grounds Director will supervise the custodial staff of the school in maintaining an adequate program of school care and maintenance.

All employees are encouraged to report promptly to the President or his designee any defects to the building or equipment that could prove injurious to the comfort, health or safety of students and staff.
