SUPERVISION OF CONSTRUCTION

MTI 648

The Institute will appoint a construction superintendent for any remodeling, addition or new construction project. The construction superintendent will be a competent person who may or may not be otherwise employed by the district. His or her primary responsibilities will be to continually inspect the construction to be certain that the interests of the public are protected and that the contractor complies strictly with the approved plans and specifications. The building superintendent will report regularly to the President and, when requested, to the Board, to keep them informed of construction progress.

The contractor will retain supervision of the actual construction and the workers whom he or she has employed to complete the actual building of the structure.
