

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

You are located at MTI, Building _____, Room/Floor_____

If you find yourself in harm's way, take fast and decisive action.

ACTIVE THREAT/SHOOTER

RUN

**IF A SAFE
PATH IS AVAILABLE**



- Have an escape route and plan in mind
- Leave your belongings
- Prevent others from entering the area

HIDE

**IF YOU CAN'T
GET OUT SAFELY**



- Silence your phone
- Lock/barricade doors
- Stay out of shooter's view and be quiet

FIGHT

**ONLY AS
LAST RESORT**



- Be physically aggressive
- Use improvised items as weapons
- Fight with all-out commitment
- Fight to incapacitate the shooter

CALL 911 WHEN IT IS SAFE TO DO SO

Information You Should Provide:

- Location, physical description, and number of shooter(s)
- Number and type of weapon held by the shooter(s)
- Number of potential victims at the location

When Law Enforcement Arrives:

- Remain calm and follow officers' instructions
- Keep hands visible at all times
- Avoid making quick movements, pointing, screaming, and/or yelling

MEDICAL EMERGENCY

- Assess the area for the safety of injured person and yourself.
- **DO NOT** move the victims unless they are in immediate danger.
- Call 911 if needed.
- If trained, provide first aid, CPR/AED. First Aid Kits available in MTI Labs & Center for Student Success.
- NARCAN for opioid overdose is available in Center for Student Success.

TORNADO WARNING

- MTECH Alert will be sent when weather service issues Tornado Warning.
 - **TAKE SHELTER IMMEDIATELY**
- Energy Training Center - West hallway
Campus Center - Main floor stairwells, CC144, CC175, CC190
Nordby Trades Center - Lower northwest hall, lower south hall.
Technology Center - TC132, TC144, TC146
Driver Training Center - Bathroom
Diesel Light Truck Bldg - Bathroom



If designated shelter is not available seek interior room or hallway on lowest floor. Stay away from windows, doors, large objects.

AED LOCATIONS

Energy Training Center - West & East hallway, Pole Lab
Campus Center - Main floor hall, 2nd & 3rd Floor hall
Nordby Trades Center - Lower & main Commons, Lower & upper hallways
Technology Center - East Hall & West Hall by Amphitheater
Driver Training Center - Main classroom
Diesel Light Truck Bldg - Main classroom



FIRE

- **ACTIVATE** nearest fire alarm if not already activated.
- **EVACUATE** building using nearest exit: **DO NOT** use elevators
- Turn off lights and close the doors to your room when leaving.
- Help others who may need assistance to evacuate.
- Move away from building to designated Rally Point - see map
- Call 911 or MTI Admin to report location of fire.



PHONE THREAT

- Stay calm and don't hang up.
- Attempt to identify who or what is being threatened.
- Attempt to identify the type of threat.
- Attempt to find the reason for the threat.
- Give a written note to someone to call 911 and MTI Administration.
