NON-ACADEMIC PROBATION, SUSPENSION AND EXPULSION

MTC 1036

The Board authorizes the President or his or her designee to place on probation, suspend or expel any student involved in any of the following:

- A. Willful violation of any published regulation for student conduct adopted or approved by the Board
- B. Conduct that substantially disrupts, impedes or interferes with the operation of any class or activity
- C. Conduct that substantially impinges upon or invades the rights of others
- D. Conduct that has resulted in conviction of the student of any criminal statute of the State of South Dakota or of the United States
- E. Disobedience of an order from a teacher, peace officer, or other school authority, when such disobedience can reasonably be anticipated to result in disorder, disruption or interference with the operation of any college class or activity or substantial and material impingement upon or invasion of the rights of others
- F. Possession of or consumption of alcoholic beverages or illegal or unauthorized drugs on college property
- G. Theft of any property belonging to MTC, faculty or staff, visitor or student
- H. Willful damage to or destruction of property belonging to the College, faculty or staff, visitor or student

Students will be afforded appropriate due process protections, including timely written notifications of all actions, and access to an appeal process in accordance with policies MTC 1044 and 1045.
