We will be revising the scoring for performance levels on the clinical practicum evaluations. They will use clear definitions of what each score means and will provide clear instructions for evaluators so hopefully we will see more consistent scoring among clinical evaluators. We also started using a Media Lab exam simulator which gives the students practice exams in all areas to help present data to detect areas that need improvement. We are in the process of collecting this data.

Our technical courses have assessment by exam, quizzes and lab practicals. These assessments also include case studies, tests to perform and evaluation of the results obtained.

This tool allows students to continually take practice exams in all areas of the lab. We are using this tool to help find areas that need improvement in our courses to help students be better prepared. It also allows students to prepare for their boards. This tool is used during their clinical site externship to allow them to continually review. We feel this is a great additional study tool.
INTERNSHIPS/ CLINICALS	How do you evaluate program competencies or learning objectives during internship/externship experiences?	We use clinical evaluations in all areas of the lab during their externship experience. The clinical coordinators evaluate students on their clinical skills and affective domain skills. The students also take 4 online exams, fill out worksheets for each department, complete differentials normal and abnormal on the Media lab website, and take practice exams on the Media lab exam simulator.

No changes have been made at this time, we are in the process of changing the grading system of the clinical evaluations so we will review the data after this year and see if their are areas of concern.

We did achieve a 75% enrollment, but barely. We have consistently been around the 89% mark, but the enrollment in 2023 was only 39% which has brought the 5 year average down significantly. All of the medical programs in 2023 had lower numbers than usual. We will monitor this to see what changes may need to be made. We are attending more career fairs in hope of increasing this number.

Our retention is at 83% so we did meet the benchmark. We have encouraged students to have study tables, we have review games and worksheets to help students be successful.
